Upon discharge the hospital, he was asked to continue therapy services in Lexington, but Roy insisted on returning to Frankfort Care and Rehab for his nursing and therapy care due to the positive experience he had the first admitted to this facility. Upon admission, Roy was a total lift, unable to stand up or transfer and in one short month Roy can now independently transfer with use of adaptive equipment. Roy has met and/or surpassed all therapy goals in his one month stay here. He can walk within his environment with walker. Roy has been a positive influence and encouraging to other residents to work hard in therapy and meet their goals.



“When I was ready to discharge from Frankfort Regional Medical Center, they wanted to send me to Lexington for therapy. I said oh no you are not, I went there the last time and ended up at Frankfort Rehab Center and that’s where I’m going again. Those people know how to take care of people! There is a difference in caring for clients and caring about clients! Here everyone really cares about you and is truly interested in your progress and how you are doing. They say hello when they pass by your room. They stop by and talk with you and take a real interest in you and the progress you’re making. Jeff, the Executive Director, stops by a couple of times a day to see how things are going. He also checks with my wife to see how she feels everything is going. You really feel like family here! We have had neighbors, friends and church members here that have all had very positive experiences. So, you’re definitely doing something right. All of the staff here are truly hard working, caring individuals.

I know when to trust a team to get me where I need to be. You see, I was a young black boy in Alabama with high aspirations in the early 1970’s. I was recruited by Kentucky State to play Collegiate Basketball. I was drafted by the Golden State Warriors. Then, I went to Europe, where I played for 10 years, winning 3 straight national titles and 4 total. I tell you all this to let you know what it is like to put your trust in the hands of people that are going to get you to the place you need to be. This is your team! I fully trust them to get me where I need to be. When they tell me I need to do this, I do this, when they tell me I need to do that, I do that. Now look, I’m leaving ahead of schedule. Plus, LNB, Jeff, LNB! I nor your team Left Nothing Behind, we gave it our all! I hope I don’t end up back in this situation, but if I do, I’m definitely coming back here!”
